1. UNDERSTANDING THE FUNDAMENTALS: VARIABLES AND EXPRESSIONS

ALGEBRA IS ESSENTIALLY A LANGUAGE OF SYMBOLS AND NUMBERS, A SOPHISTICATED SYSTEM OF SHORTHAND FOR EXPRESSING RELATIONSHIPS. THE CORE BUILDING BLOCK IS THE VARIABLE, USUALLY REPRESENTED BY LETTERS (LIKE x , y , z). THESE VARIABLES STAND IN FOR UNKNOWN QUANTITIES. WE THEN USE THESE VARIABLES TO CONSTRUCT ALGEBRAIC EXPRESSIONS, WHICH ARE COMBINATIONS OF VARIABLES, NUMBERS, AND MATHEMATICAL OPERATIONS ($+$, $-$, $\times$, $\div$). FOR EXAMPLE, $3x + 5$ IS AN ALGEBRAIC EXPRESSION. UNDERSTANDING HOW TO SIMPLIFY AND MANIPULATE THESE EXPRESSIONS IS FUNDAMENTAL TO MASTERING ALGEBRA. WE'LL COVER SIMPLIFYING EXPRESSIONS INVOLVING LIKE TERMS, THE DISTRIBUTIVE PROPERTY (REMEMBER FOIL?), AND ORDER OF OPERATIONS (PEMDAS/BODMAS).

2. SOLVING EQUATIONS: UNLOCKING THE UNKNOWN

THE HEART OF ALGEBRA LIES IN SOLVING EQUATIONS. AN EQUATION SHOWS THAT TWO EXPRESSIONS ARE EQUAL. OUR GOAL IS TO FIND THE VALUE(S) OF THE VARIABLE(S) THAT MAKE THE EQUATION TRUE. WE ACHIEVE THIS BY MANIPULATING THE EQUATION USING INVERSE OPERATIONS, MAINTAINING BALANCE ON BOTH SIDES. WE'LL EXPLORE DIFFERENT TYPES OF EQUATIONS, INCLUDING LINEAR EQUATIONS (THOSE WITH VARIABLES RAISED TO THE POWER OF 1), AND DEMONSTRATE METHODS LIKE ISOLATING THE VARIABLE, USING INVERSE OPERATIONS (ADDITION/SUBTRACTION, MULTIPLICATION/DIVISION), AND SOLVING MULTI-STEP EQUATIONS. WE'LL ALSO TACKLE EQUATIONS WITH FRACTIONS AND DECIMALS.

3. INEQUALITIES: EXPLORING RANGES OF SOLUTIONS

UNLIKE EQUATIONS, WHICH HAVE SPECIFIC SOLUTIONS, INEQUALITIES DESCRIBE A RANGE OF SOLUTIONS. INSTEAD OF AN EQUALS SIGN ($=$), WE USE SYMBOLS LIKE $<$ (LESS THAN), $>$ (GREATER THAN), $\leq$ (LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO), AND $\geq$ (GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO). SOLVING INEQUALITIES INVOLVES SIMILAR TECHNIQUES TO SOLVING EQUATIONS, BUT WITH ONE CRUCIAL DIFFERENCE: WHEN MULTIPLYING OR DIVIDING BY A NEGATIVE NUMBER, YOU MUST REVERSE THE INEQUALITY SIGN. WE'LL EXPLORE SOLVING SIMPLE AND COMPOUND INEQUALITIES, AND GRAPHICALLY REPRESENTING THEIR SOLUTIONS ON A NUMBER LINE.

4. GRAPHING LINEAR EQUATIONS: VISUALIZING RELATIONSHIPS

VISUALIZING ALGEBRAIC RELATIONSHIPS IS CRUCIAL FOR UNDERSTANDING THEM DEEPLY. GRAPHING LINEAR EQUATIONS PROVIDES A VISUAL REPRESENTATION OF THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN VARIABLES. WE'LL COVER PLOTTING POINTS ON A COORDINATE PLANE, FINDING THE SLOPE AND Y-INTERCEPT OF A LINE, AND UNDERSTANDING DIFFERENT FORMS OF LINEAR EQUATIONS (SLOPE-INTERCEPT FORM, POINT-SLOPE FORM, STANDARD FORM). THIS SECTION WILL TEACH YOU HOW TO GRAPH LINEAR EQUATIONS FROM THEIR EQUATIONS AND INTERPRET THE MEANING OF THE SLOPE AND INTERCEPTS IN REAL-WORLD CONTEXTS.

5. SYSTEMS OF EQUATIONS: SOLVING MULTIPLE EQUATIONS SIMULTANEOUSLY

OFTEN, WE ENCOUNTER SITUATIONS REQUIRING US TO SOLVE MULTIPLE EQUATIONS SIMULTANEOUSLY. THIS IS WHERE SYSTEMS OF EQUATIONS COME INTO PLAY. WE'LL EXPLORE METHODS LIKE SUBSTITUTION AND ELIMINATION TO FIND THE SOLUTION(S) TO SYSTEMS OF LINEAR EQUATIONS. WE'LL ALSO DISCUSS HOW TO INTERPRET THE SOLUTIONS GRAPHICALLY, LOOKING FOR POINTS OF INTERSECTION BETWEEN LINES. THIS SECTION LAYS THE GROUNDWORK FOR MORE ADVANCED ALGEBRAIC CONCEPTS.

6. EXPONENTS AND POLYNOMIALS: BUILDING BLOCKS OF ADVANCED ALGEBRA

THIS SECTION INTRODUCES MORE ADVANCED CONCEPTS, FORMING THE BRIDGE TO MORE COMPLEX ALGEBRA. QUADRATIC EQUATIONS, THOSE CONTAINING A VARIABLE RAISED TO THE POWER OF 2, REPRESENT A SIGNIFICANT LEAP IN COMPLEXITY. WE'LL EXPLORE SEVERAL METHODS FOR SOLVING QUADRATIC EQUATIONS, INCLUDING FACTORING, USING THE QUADRATIC FORMULA, AND COMPLETING THE SQUARE. WE'LL ALSO EXAMINE THE DISCRIMINANT AND ITS IMPLICATIONS FOR THE NUMBER AND NATURE OF SOLUTIONS. THIS SECTION IS CRUCIAL FOR UNDERSTANDING PARABOLIC FUNCTIONS AND THEIR APPLICATIONS.
