Avenick played a key role in the research and writing of *Sports in America* and *Chesapeake*, and introduced Michener to Melissa (Missy) DeMaio, who soon became the primary reason for Michener's increasingly frequent visits to the Keys. Biographers and critics have long agreed that Michener's personality and his characters were both affected by his relationship with DeMaio. As perhaps his most encompassing autobiographical novel, and the one written in the midst of these changes, *Matecumbe* provides what may be tantalizing glimpses into Michener's life.
