PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO DETAILS LIKE TEXTURES AND COLORS. USING A ZOOMING FUNCTION, IF AVAILABLE, IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

LEVEL 21-30: ADVANCED CHALLENGES

THIS IS WHERE THE GAME TRULY TESTS YOUR OBSERVATION SKILLS. THE BACKGROUNDS ARE MORE COMPLEX, THE OBJECTS ARE SMALLER AND MORE INTRICATELY HIDDEN, AND THE TIME CONSTRAINTS (IF ANY) BECOME MORE PRESSING. PRACTICE FOCUSING ON SPECIFIC AREAS AND ELIMINATING POSSIBILITIES METHODICALLY.

LEVEL 31 AND BEYOND: MASTER THE GAME

THE LATER LEVELS OFTEN REQUIRE A KEEN EYE FOR DETAIL AND A STRATEGIC APPROACH. UTILIZE ANY AVAILABLE HINTS OR MAGNIFYING TOOLS. REMEMBER, PATIENCE AND PERSISTENCE ARE KEY. DON'T BE AFRAID TO TAKE BREAKS AND RETURN TO A LEVEL WITH FRESH EYES.

TIPS AND TRICKS FOR SUCCESS

SYSTEMATIC SCANNING: DIVIDE THE IMAGE INTO SECTIONS AND SCAN EACH SYSTEMATICALLY.
