A STRUCTURED APPROACH TO FINDING AND UNDERSTANDING PRE-CALC ANSWERS

INSTEAD OF SEARCHING FOR QUICK SOLUTIONS, DEVELOP A METHODICAL APPROACH TO TACKLING PRECALCULUS PROBLEMS:

1. READ THE PROBLEM CAREFULLY: IDENTIFY THE KEY INFORMATION AND WHAT IS BEING ASKED.
2. IDENTIFY THE RELEVANT CONCEPTS: DETERMINE WHICH FORMULAS, THEOREMS, OR TECHNIQUES ARE APPLICABLE.
3. DEVELOP A PLAN: OUTLINE THE STEPS NECESSARY TO SOLVE THE PROBLEM.
4. SHOW YOUR WORK: THIS HELPS IDENTIFY ERRORS AND REINFORCES YOUR UNDERSTANDING.
5. CHECK YOUR ANSWER: DOES YOUR ANSWER MAKE SENSE IN THE CONTEXT OF THE PROBLEM? USE ALTERNATIVE METHODS IF POSSIBLE TO VERIFY YOUR SOLUTION.

EXAMPLE PROBLEM AND SOLUTION (ILLUSTRATIVE)

LET'S CONSIDER A SIMPLE EXAMPLE: SOLVE FOR x : $2x + 5 = 11$.

1. READ: WE NEED TO FIND THE VALUE OF x .
2. CONCEPTS: THIS INVOLVES BASIC ALGEBRA.
3. PLAN: SUBTRACT 5 FROM BOTH SIDES, THEN DIVIDE BY 2.
4. SOLUTION: $2x + 5 - 5 = 11 - 5 \Rightarrow 2x = 6 \Rightarrow x = 3$
5. CHECK: $2(3) + 5 = 11$. THE ANSWER IS CORRECT.

THIS SIMPLE EXAMPLE ILLUSTRATES THE IMPORTANCE OF A STRUCTURED APPROACH. WHILE FINDING THE ANSWER ($x=3$) IS QUICK, THE PROCESS OF UNDERSTANDING HOW TO GET THERE IS WHAT TRULY MATTERS.
