This section also has foldouts; one of them spans six pages and contains a map or diagram, with nine islands or rosettes connected by causeways and containing castles, as well as what may possibly be a volcano. Pharmaceutical: Many labeled drawings of isolated plant parts (roots, leaves, etc.); objects resembling apothecary jars, ranging in style from the mundane to the fantastical; and a few text paragraphs.
