THE ENLIGHTENMENT, WITH THINKERS LIKE JOHN LOCKE, JEAN-JACQUES ROUSSEAU, AND MONTESQUIEU, PROVIDED THE PHILOSOPHICAL FOUNDATIONS FOR MODERN DEMOCRACY. LOCKE'S EMPHASIS ON NATURAL RIGHTS AND LIMITED GOVERNMENT, ROUSSEAU'S CONCEPT OF THE SOCIAL CONTRACT, AND MONTESQUIEU'S ADVOCACY FOR THE SEPARATION OF POWERS PROFOUNDLY INFLUENCED THE DEVELOPMENT OF DEMOCRATIC SYSTEMS. THE AMERICAN AND FRENCH REVOLUTIONS, SPURRED BY ENLIGHTENMENT IDEALS, LED TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF REPUBLICS WITH CONSTITUTIONS THAT ENSHRINED PRINCIPLES OF INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY, LIMITED GOVERNMENT, AND REPRESENTATIVE DEMOCRACY.

CHAPTER 2: KEY PRINCIPLES OF DEMOCRACY: RULE OF LAW, INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS, POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY, ETC.

FINALLY, ACCOUNTABILITY MEANS THAT GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR ACTIONS TO THE PEOPLE AND ARE SUBJECT TO MECHANISMS OF OVERSIGHT AND REDRESS.

CHAPTER 3: DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS: LEGISLATURES, EXECUTIVES, JUDICIARIES

OTHER CHALLENGES INCLUDE CORRUPTION, INEQUALITY, AND THE SPREAD OF MISINFORMATION, ALL OF WHICH CAN UNDERMINE DEMOCRATIC INSTITUTIONS AND PUBLIC TRUST.
