As an initial step in moving from national-level dialogue and speculations to concerted local and state level work on the role of algebra in the curriculum, the MSEB and the NCTM co-sponsored a national symposium, *The Nature and Role of Algebra in the K-14 Curriculum*, on May 27 and 28, 1997, at the National Academy of Sciences in Washington, D.C.

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
