INTERPRETATION: WHAT DOES THE TEXT MEAN? WHAT IS THE AUTHOR'S INTENDED MESSAGE? CONSIDER THE HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL CONTEXT. CONSULT COMMENTARIES AND OTHER RESOURCES TO BROADEN YOUR UNDERSTANDING. AVOID IMPOSING YOUR OWN PRECONCEIVED NOTIONS.

APPLICATION: HOW DOES THIS PASSAGE APPLY TO MY LIFE? HOW CAN I PUT THE PRINCIPLES INTO PRACTICE? IDENTIFY AREAS WHERE YOU NEED TO GROW SPIRITUALLY OR MAKE CHANGES IN YOUR BEHAVIOR. PRAY FOR GUIDANCE AND DISCERNMENT.

WHAT IS THE GENRE OF THIS PASSAGE (NARRATIVE, POETRY, PROPHECY, LAW, ETC.)?
WHAT LITERARY DEVICES ARE USED (METAPHOR, SIMILE, HYPERBOLE, ETC.)?
HOW DOES THE STRUCTURE OF THE PASSAGE CONTRIBUTE TO ITS MEANING?

HISTORICAL-CULTURAL QUESTIONS: THESE EXPLORE THE HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL CONTEXT OF THE PASSAGE. FOR EXAMPLE:
WHEN AND WHERE WAS THIS WRITTEN?
WHO WAS THE INTENDED AUDIENCE?
WHAT WERE THE SOCIAL, POLITICAL, AND RELIGIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE TIME?

THEOLOGICAL QUESTIONS: THESE EXPLORE THE THEOLOGICAL IMPLICATIONS OF THE PASSAGE. FOR EXAMPLE:
WHAT ARE THE MAIN THEOLOGICAL THEMES?
HOW DOES THIS PASSAGE RELATE TO OTHER PARTS OF SCRIPTURE?
WHAT DOES THIS PASSAGE TEACH ABOUT GOD, HUMANITY, SALVATION, AND THE CHRISTIAN LIFE?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS: THESE FOCUS ON HOW THE PASSAGE CAN BE APPLIED TO DAILY LIFE. FOR EXAMPLE:

WHAT ARE THE KEY PRINCIPLES OR TEACHINGS IN THIS PASSAGE?

HOW CAN I APPLY THESE PRINCIPLES TO MY OWN LIFE?

WHAT CHANGES DO I NEED TO MAKE IN MY THOUGHTS, WORDS, OR ACTIONS?

III. EXAMPLE BIBLE STUDY GUIDE: THE PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN (LUKE 10:25-37)

LET'S ILLUSTRATE THESE METHODS WITH THE PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN:

OBSERVATION: A LAWYER ASKS JESUS ABOUT INHERITING ETERNAL LIFE. JESUS TELLS HIM TO LOVE GOD AND HIS NEIGHBOR. THE LAWYER ASKS WHO HIS NEIGHBOR IS. JESUS RESPONDS WITH THE PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN. NOTE THE CONTRASTING ACTIONS OF THE PRIEST, LEVITE, AND SAMARITAN.

INTERPRETATION: THE PARABLE HIGHLIGHTS THE TRUE MEANING OF "NEIGHBOR." IT TRANSCENDS ETHNIC AND RELIGIOUS BOUNDARIES. JESUS EMPHASIZES COMPASSION AND SELFLESS SERVICE AS ESSENTIAL ASPECTS OF LOVING ONE'S NEIGHBOR. THE SAMARITAN, AN UNEXPECTED HERO, DEMONSTRATES RADICAL LOVE AND MERCY.

APPLICATION: HOW CAN I SHOW COMPASSION AND MERCY TO OTHERS, REGARDLESS OF THEIR BACKGROUND OR CIRCUMSTANCES? AM I WILLING TO GO OUT OF MY WAY TO HELP SOMEONE IN NEED? WHAT ARE THE BARRIERS PREVENTING ME FROM LOVING MY NEIGHBOR AS MYSELF?
