UNDERSTANDING THE CA SECRETARY OF STATE’S ROLE IN BUSINESS INFORMATION

THE CALIFORNIA SECRETARY OF STATE IS THE OFFICIAL RECORD KEEPER FOR ALL BUSINESSES REGISTERED WITHIN THE STATE. THIS INCLUDES CORPORATIONS, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES (LLCs), PARTNERSHIPS, AND OTHER BUSINESS ENTITIES. THE OFFICE MAINTAINS A COMPREHENSIVE DATABASE ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC, ENSURING TRANSPARENCY AND FACILITATING LEGITIMATE BUSINESS DEALINGS.

ACCESSING THE CA SOS BUSINESS SEARCH PORTAL

ACCESSING THE CA SECRETARY OF STATE’S BUSINESS SEARCH PORTAL IS STRAIGHTFORWARD. SIMPLY NAVIGATE TO THE OFFICIAL WEBSITE (USUALLY A READILY-AVAILABLE SEARCH RESULT) AND LOCATE THE BUSINESS SEARCH LINK, OFTEN PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED ON THE HOMEPAGE. THE SITE IS DESIGNED FOR USER-FRIENDLY NAVIGATION.

DIFFERENT SEARCH METHODS AVAILABLE ON THE CA SOS WEBSITE

THE CA SOS OFFERS MULTIPLE SEARCH METHODS TO CATER TO VARIOUS USER NEEDS.

SEARCHING BY BUSINESS NAME

THIS IS THE MOST COMMON METHOD. ENTER THE EXACT OR PARTIAL BUSINESS NAME INTO THE SEARCH BAR. THE SYSTEM USUALLY PROVIDES A LIST OF MATCHING RESULTS, ALLOWING YOU TO REFINE YOUR SEARCH IF NECESSARY.

SEARCHING BY BUSINESS ENTITY NUMBER (FEIN/EIN)

IF YOU KNOW THE BUSINESS'S FEDERAL EMPLOYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (FEIN) OR EMPLOYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (EIN), YOU CAN USE THIS FOR A MORE PRECISE SEARCH, YIELDING QUICKER AND MORE ACCURATE RESULTS.

SEARCHING BY AGENT NAME/ADDRESS

THIS OPTION IS USEFUL IF YOU KNOW THE REGISTERED AGENT'S NAME OR ADDRESS ASSOCIATED WITH THE BUSINESS. THE REGISTERED AGENT ACTS AS THE OFFICIAL POINT OF CONTACT FOR LEGAL AND OFFICIAL COMMUNICATIONS.

SEARCHING BY BUSINESS ADDRESS

SEARCHING USING THE BUSINESS'S PHYSICAL ADDRESS CAN BE EFFECTIVE, THOUGH IT MIGHT RETURN MULTIPLE RESULTS IF MULTIPLE BUSINESSES OPERATE AT THE SAME ADDRESS.

INFORMATION RETRIEVED FROM A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESS SEARCH

A SUCCESSFUL SEARCH TYPICALLY YIELDS A WEALTH OF INFORMATION, INCLUDING:

BUSINESS NAME AND TYPE

THIS REVEALS THE OFFICIAL NAME AND THE LEGAL STRUCTURE OF THE BUSINESS (E.G., CORPORATION, LLC).

REGISTERED AGENT INFORMATION

YOU'LL FIND THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE REGISTERED AGENT, A CRUCIAL PIECE OF INFORMATION FOR OFFICIAL COMMUNICATIONS.

BUSINESS ADDRESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

THE SEARCH RESULTS USUALLY DISPLAY BOTH THE PHYSICAL BUSINESS ADDRESS AND THE MAILING ADDRESS, WHICH MAY BE DIFFERENT.

FILING DATE AND STATUS

THIS INDICATES WHEN THE BUSINESS WAS INITIALLY REGISTERED AND ITS CURRENT STATUS (ACTIVE, SUSPENDED, DISSOLVED).

PRINCIPAL OFFICE ADDRESS

THIS IS THE MAIN LOCATION WHERE THE BUSINESS CONDUCTS ITS OPERATIONS.

INTERPRETING SEARCH RESULTS AND UNDERSTANDING BUSINESS STATUSES (ACTIVE, SUSPENDED, DISSOLVED)

UNDERSTANDING THE STATUS OF A BUSINESS IS CRITICAL. "ACTIVE" MEANS THE BUSINESS IS IN GOOD STANDING. "SUSPENDED" SUGGESTS ISSUES WITH COMPLIANCE, WHILE "DISSOLVED" INDICATES THE BUSINESS IS NO LONGER OPERATING.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON SEARCH ISSUES

IF YOUR SEARCH YIELDS NO RESULTS, DOUBLE-CHECK YOUR SPELLING AND TRY VARIATIONS OF THE BUSINESS NAME. IF PROBLEMS PERSIST, CONTACT THE CA SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE DIRECTLY FOR ASSISTANCE.

ALTERNATIVE RESOURCES FOR CALIFORNIA BUSINESS INFORMATION

WHILE THE CA SOS IS THE PRIMARY SOURCE, OTHER RESOURCES LIKE THE CALIFORNIA FRANCHISE TAX BOARD WEBSITE CAN PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION, PARTICULARLY CONCERNING TAX-RELATED DETAILS.

The Code was first published in 1926, and a new edition of the code has been published every six years since 1934. The 2012 edition of the Code incorporates laws enacted through the One Hundred Twelfth Congress, Second Session, the last of which was signed by the President on January 15, 2013. It does not include laws of the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress, First Session, enacted between January 2, 2013, the date it convened, and January 15, 2013. By statutory authority this edition may be cited U.S.C. 2012 ed. As adopted in 1926, the Code established *prima facie* the general and permanent laws of the United States. The underlying statutes reprinted in the Code remained in effect and controlled over the Code in case of any discrepancy. In 1947, Congress began enacting individual titles of the Code into positive law. When a title is enacted into positive law, the underlying statutes are repealed and the title then becomes legal evidence of the law. Currently, 26 of the 51 titles in the Code have been so enacted. These are identified in the table of titles near the beginning of each volume. The Law Revision Counsel of the House of Representatives continues to prepare legislation pursuant to 2 U.S.C. 285b to enact the remainder of the Code, on a title-by-title basis, into positive law.
