ADDRESSING THESE CONCERNS REQUIRES THOUGHTFUL CONSIDERATION AND PROACTIVE MEASURES TO MITIGATE POTENTIAL NEGATIVE INFLUENCES.

FAMILIES CAN CREATE THEIR OWN TRADITIONS, SUCH AS HOSTING A "SAINTS' PARTY" WITH COSTUME-THEMED

ACTIVITIES, OR ORGANIZING A NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICE PROJECT.

V. PARENTAL GUIDANCE AND DISCERNMENT: PROTECTING CHILDREN'S FAITH
