2. TOM HAD 52 MARBLES. HE LOST 18 IN A GAME. HOW MANY MARBLES DOES TOM HAVE LEFT?
3. IF A TRAIN HAS 3 CARRIAGES, AND EACH CARRIAGE HOLDS 25 PASSENGERS, HOW MANY PASSENGERS ARE ON THE TRAIN IN TOTAL?
4. A BAKER MADE 75 COOKIES. HE SOLD 32 COOKIES IN THE MORNING AND 17 IN THE AFTERNOON. HOW MANY COOKIES DOES HE HAVE LEFT?
5. SARAH SCORED 23 POINTS IN A GAME, AND MARK SCORED 19 POINTS. WHAT IS THE TOTAL SCORE OF SARAH AND MARK?

SECTION 2: MULTIPLICATION MANIA! (MATHS QUIZ FOR 8 YEAR OLDS)

3. CALCULATE 9×3 .
4. A BOX CONTAINS 12 EGGS. HOW MANY EGGS ARE THERE IN 5 BOXES?
5. WHAT IS 2 MULTIPLIED BY 2 MULTIPLIED BY 2 ($2 \times 2 \times 2$)?

SECTION 3: DIVISION DELIGHTS! (MATHS QUIZ FOR 8 YEAR OLDS)

DIVISION IS THE OPPOSITE OF MULTIPLICATION! LET'S SEE HOW WELL YOU CAN SPLIT THINGS UP.

1. SHARE 36 SWEETS EQUALLY BETWEEN 4 CHILDREN. HOW MANY SWEETS DOES EACH CHILD GET?
2. IF YOU HAVE 24 PENCILS AND YOU WANT TO PUT THEM INTO 3 POTS EQUALLY, HOW MANY PENCILS GO IN EACH POT?
3. WHAT IS 45 DIVIDED BY 5?
4. A GROUP OF 28 STUDENTS ARE DIVIDED INTO 4 TEAMS FOR A SPORTS DAY. HOW MANY STUDENTS ARE IN EACH TEAM?
5. DIVIDE 63 BY 7.

SECTION 4: WORD PROBLEMS – PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER! (MATHS QUIZ FOR 8 YEAR OLDS)

NOW LET'S TACKLE SOME WORD PROBLEMS! THESE REQUIRE YOU TO READ CAREFULLY AND DECIDE WHICH OPERATION (ADDITION, SUBTRACTION, MULTIPLICATION, OR DIVISION) TO USE.

1. LIAM BOUGHT A BOOK FOR £5 AND A TOY CAR FOR £8. HE PAID WITH A £20 NOTE. HOW MUCH CHANGE DID HE RECEIVE?
2. A FARMER HAS 15 SHEEP AND BUYS ANOTHER 23. HOW MANY SHEEP DOES THE FARMER HAVE IN TOTAL?
3. THERE ARE 30 STUDENTS IN A CLASS, AND THEY ARE SPLIT INTO GROUPS OF 6 FOR A PROJECT. HOW MANY GROUPS ARE THERE?
4. MARIA BAKED 24 CUPCAKES. SHE WANTS TO PUT THEM IN BOXES OF 6. HOW MANY BOXES DOES SHE NEED?
5. DAVID COLLECTED 12 STAMPS ON MONDAY, 15 ON TUESDAY, AND 8 ON WEDNESDAY. HOW MANY STAMPS DID HE COLLECT IN TOTAL?

MAKING MATHS FUN FOR 8-YEAR-OLDS

REMEMBER, LEARNING SHOULD BE FUN! HERE ARE A FEW TIPS TO MAKE MATHS MORE ENGAGING FOR YOUR 8-YEAR-OLD:

USE REAL-LIFE EXAMPLES: INCORPORATE MATHS INTO EVERYDAY ACTIVITIES, SUCH AS COUNTING COINS, MEASURING INGREDIENTS FOR BAKING, OR CALCULATING DISTANCES DURING A CAR JOURNEY.

GAMIFY LEARNING: USE ONLINE GAMES OR APPS THAT MAKE LEARNING MATHS INTERACTIVE AND ENTERTAINING.

MAKE IT VISUAL: USE COLOURFUL MANIPULATIVES, DRAWINGS, OR CHARTS TO HELP VISUALIZE MATHEMATICAL CONCEPTS.

PRAISE EFFORT, NOT JUST RESULTS: ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO TRY THEIR BEST, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY GET THE RIGHT ANSWER IMMEDIATELY.

KEEP IT SHORT AND SWEET: AVOID LONG, TEDIOUS SESSIONS. SHORT, FOCUSED BURSTS OF LEARNING ARE OFTEN MORE EFFECTIVE.

1. ARE THERE ANY FREE ONLINE RESOURCES TO HELP WITH MATHS PRACTICE? YES, THERE ARE MANY! SEARCH FOR "FREE MATHS GAMES FOR 8-YEAR-OLDS" OR "ONLINE MATHS WORKSHEETS FOR GRADE 3" TO FIND A WEALTH OF RESOURCES. KHAN ACADEMY AND IXL ARE POPULAR CHOICES.
1. HOW OFTEN SHOULD MY CHILD PRACTICE MATHS? AIM FOR SHORT, REGULAR PRACTICE SESSIONS RATHER THAN INFREQUENT, LENGTHY ONES. EVEN 15-20 MINUTES A DAY CAN MAKE A SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCE.
1. IS IT OKAY TO USE CALCULATORS? FOR BASIC ADDITION, SUBTRACTION, MULTIPLICATION, AND DIVISION, IT'S GENERALLY BETTER TO ENCOURAGE MENTAL CALCULATION AND THE USE OF OTHER METHODS FIRST TO BUILD A STRONG FOUNDATION. CALCULATORS CAN BE INTRODUCED LATER AS A TOOL FOR MORE COMPLEX PROBLEMS.
1. WHAT IF MY CHILD DOESN'T ENJOY MATHS? TRY DIFFERENT APPROACHES. MAKE IT FUN AND ENGAGING. FOCUS ON THEIR STRENGTHS AND BUILD CONFIDENCE. CONNECT MATHS TO THEIR INTERESTS, AND CELEBRATE THEIR PROGRESS, NO MATTER HOW SMALL.
