THESE CELLS, REMARKABLY, WERE UNLIKE ANY SEEN BEFORE. THEY WERE IMMORTAL – CAPABLE OF CONTINUOUS REPLICATION – UNLIKE NORMAL HUMAN CELLS. THESE "HELA CELLS" BECAME A CORNERSTONE OF MODERN MEDICAL RESEARCH, CONTRIBUTING TO COUNTLESS BREAKTHROUGHS IN VIROLOGY, GENETICS, AND CANCER RESEARCH. POLIO VACCINES, GENE MAPPING, IN-VITRO FERTILIZATION – THESE ARE JUST A FEW EXAMPLES OF THE ADVANCEMENTS MADE POSSIBLE BY HELa CELLS.
