THIS APPROACH – ANALYZING CHARACTER MOTIVATIONS, EXPLORING THEMATIC ELEMENTS, AND USING TEXTUAL EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT YOUR CLAIMS – IS KEY TO EFFECTIVELY ANSWERING WORKBOOK QUESTIONS THROUGHOUT THE NOVEL.

KEY THEMES AND THEIR MANIFESTATION

CAN ENRICH YOUR UNDERSTANDING AND PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SUPPORT FOR YOUR ARGUMENTS. ALWAYS CITE YOUR SOURCES PROPERLY.
