ADLER EMPHASIZED THE IMPORTANCE OF CONSIDERING THE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC CONTEXT IN WHICH FEMALE CRIME OCCURS, MOVING BEYOND SIMPLISTIC EXPLANATIONS ROOTED IN BIOLOGICAL OR PSYCHOLOGICAL DETERMINISM. A MORE HOLISTIC APPROACH, INCORPORATING THESE MULTIFACETED DIMENSIONS, MIGHT HAVE PROVIDED A RICHER UNDERSTANDING OF THE PHENOMENON.

THE LASTING LEGACY OF FREDA ADLER: SHAPING MODERN CRIMINOLOGY
