HIS PARTNERSHIP WITH HARRIET TAYLOR, A WOMAN OF EXCEPTIONAL INTELLECT AND A SIGNIFICANT INFLUENCE ON HIS THINKING, FURTHER SHAPED HIS UNDERSTANDING OF THE INJUSTICE FACED BY WOMEN. THEIR COLLABORATION AND HER OWN WRITINGS PLAYED A CRUCIAL ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF HIS ARGUMENTS.

MILL'S CENTRAL ARGUMENTS: CHALLENGING THE STATUS QUO

THE NATURE VS. NURTURE DEBATE: A CORNERSTONE OF MILL'S ARGUMENT
